



Registered Midwife Nanaimo, Vancouver Island

Island Health's Division of Midwifery has two full-time opportunities for Registered Midwives at the Nanaimo Regional General Hospital.

The successful applicant will be a registered Midwife, be eligible to obtain full licensure with the B.C. College of Midwives, and demonstrate suitable experience and training.

Midwives in B.C. are required to practice in both the home and hospital settings. They are independent practitioners with their own practices in the community and have admitting privileges at Nanaimo Regional General Hospital.
