

Registered Midwives needed in beautiful British Columbia

The Maternal Infant Child Youth (MICY) Program of the Fraser Health Authority (FHA) is inviting interested midwives to apply for medical staff privileges. There are currently seven (7) FHA sites with vacancies for midwives: Abbotsford Regional Hospital, Abbotsford, BC; Burnaby Hospital, Burnaby, BC; Chilliwack General Hospital, Chilliwack, BC; Langley Memorial Hospital, Langley, BC; Ridge Meadows Hospital, Maple Ridge, BC; Royal Columbian Hospital,New Westminster, BC; Surrey Memorial Hospital, Surrey, BC.

About Fraser Health Authority

Fraser Health is BC's largest and fastest growing health authority, serving more than 1.6 million people, or one out of every three British Columbians. Fraser Health's population has doubled since 1986, and by 2020, our population is expected to grow by 20 per cent, or another 327,000 people.

The FHA Division of Midwifery was established in 2010 and falls under the umbrella of the Department of Obstetrics and Gynecology, in the Maternal Infant Child Youth (MICY) Program. The Division of Midwifery follows FHA's Strategic Direction striving to further develop midwifery in our health authority by addressing capacity, quality and safety, integration, progressive partnerships, research and academic development and great workplaces. There are more than 90 midwives organized into approximately 20 community-based clinics serving women within the Fraser region from the northwest in Burnaby to the southwest in White Rock and along the corridor to the east in Hope.

Criteria for Eligibility

Members of the FHA Division of Midwifery are autonomous health care professionals and work in community-based clinics. Successful candidates must be eligible for registration with the College of Midwives of BC <u>www.cmbc.bc.ca</u>. They are required to maintain medical staff privileges through adherence to FHA Medical Staff Rules and Medical Staff Bylaws. FHA medical staff members are expected to participate in Division committee work, attend regional Division and Department meetings, as well as adhere to the mandatory vaccination policy as outlined in the Medical Staff Rules.
