- We practice in a primary care model with a case load of around 3 clients per month per midwife with privileges at South Shore Regional Hospital in Bridgewater, and an approximate 30-40% home birth rate. We have second attendants to assist at home births, allowing for regular off-call time. Our clinic is located in the charming town of Lunenburg, by the sea.
- Midwives are employed by the Nova Scotia Health Authority, and are respected members of the local maternity care team with excellent communication and relationships with nurses, obstetricians, family physicians and nurse practitioners in the area.
- We enjoy serving a diverse clientele.

The South Shore has several picturesque small towns scattered throughout the rural landscape, with beautiful beaches, rivers and pristine coastline; lovely inland forests and many parks. Sail, surf, cycle or stroll - our varied landscape offers abundant outdoor opportunities. Our small communities are rich in history as evidenced in our unique and well preserved architecture.
