We will be offering 40 BCCs (dependant on client demand) over a one year, and one month, contract (Sept 1st 2017-Sept 3, 2018) in a shared care model.

CMK is a busy rural/urban teaching practice, we serve Kingston and surrounding communities within a 50 km radius. Kingston is a vibrant, beautiful city with a diverse population and our clinic is striving to reach out and provide care to more women within our multicultural population.

As midwives we hold privileges at Kingston General Hospital, a tertiary-level, teaching hospital where we enjoy a good working relationship. We currently manage epidurals however oxytocin is a TOC. Approximately 20% of our clients choose to give birth at home.
