**A position in Kingston for a General Registrant  
(part-time position for a 12 month contract - with potential for longer)**

Community Midwives of Kingston is looking for a General Registrant who would like to join our group of fun-loving, supportive midwives. As with most practices our group finds itself with midwives whose lives are constantly changing and as one of our midwives needs to take a leave of absence we are curious as to who might come and join us and add to the type of quality care we provide to clients and their families in Kingston.

Kingston is a great place to live and we enjoy a thriving practice that provides care to clients from urban and rural settings. As midwives we have established a solid working relationship with the obstetrical staff at our teaching hospital (KGH) and enjoy the supportive environment that has developed there over the years. At present our scope at KGH includes epidurals, foley inductions and we are working on protocols to expand our scope (i.e. ECV, oxytocin IOL, ...) Home birth is a priority for us as a group and we would welcome applicants who share our commitment to supporting this choice of birth place.

We are offering the successful candidate a 12 month contract with the opportunity to work in an unique triple team model for the first nine months. With 25 BCCs/year this established team of midwives work one week of clinic, one week of on/call and then one week protected holiday time. It is a great model for a General Registrant who wants to live in Kingston and enjoy a balanced lifestyle. (The model of care for the last 3months of this contract would depend on team switches and client demand).

Ideally the start date for this position would be clinic as of December 1st 2018 as we already have clients in care for January 2019 for this position. We appreciate that this is short notice and would be as flexible as possible with this date should an applicant who is an obvious fit with our practice need us to adjust this timing. We want applicants to know that there is potential to stay with CMK beyond this contract as, mentioned above, the uncertainty of midwives' lives and the growing number of clients means there is often potential to grow the practice. In the past 5 years we have grown rapidly from 7 to 13 midwives and it is exciting to think of who might join us next.
