Midwives of Headwater Hills is a well-established practice that opened in 2009. Our practice is central to Orangeville, but also provides services to outlying areas including Shelburne, Caledon, Grand Valley, Mono and Bolton. Orangeville is a growing community with charming amenities and a friendly small-town atmosphere. There are plentiful opportunities for outdoor recreation as well as close proximity to major city centres for entertainment and shopping.

Our practice holds hospital privileges at Headwaters Health Care Centre in Orangeville, a level 1 hospital which handles approximately 750 births annually. We enjoy positive inter-professional relationships and are responsible for approximately 25% of the maternity care in the community. Our hospital offers 24/7 obstetric, anaesthesia and pediatric coverage as well as in-house lactation consultants and a supportive complement of RNs and RPNs. We maintain care for epidurals, however oxytocin is a transfer of care.

We function as a practice of five midwives working in a shared care model that provides one week on-call and one week off-call as well as 10 weeks vacation per year. We are looking for an organized and energetic midwife to join us asap this fall. This could be a new registrant for a one year contract, a 6-8 month general registrant locum, or a general registrant for a one year contract with possibility to continue in the right circumstances.

Applicants should be:

- keen to contribute to non-clinical work including outreach and resource development
- dedicated to the promotion of home birth and informed choice
- innovative and enthusiastic with a good sense of humour and excellent communication skills
- interested in and skilled at developing positive inter-professional relationships
