Required qualifications:

- A valid Alberta Class 5 Driver's License and the use of a private vehicle are conditions of contract.
- Prior midwifery experience in Canada, preferably Alberta.

Hours of Work: On call roster and clinical rotation as established with midwifery team

Compensation: Course of Care funding with an attractive benefit plan available through the Midwifery Practice and the Alberta Association of Midwives. Professional liability insurance is subsidized by the AHS and managed through the Alberta Association of Midwives. Relocation assistance may be available.
