We provide care in the City of Windsor and Essex County, with two clinics. Our main clinic is in the heart of the City of Windsor and we have a satellite clinic in Leamington, to provide close-to-home access to care for our county clients. The furthest part of our catchment area is less than a 1-hour drive from Windsor.

We serve a diverse community including many newcomers to Canada, Mennonites, and OMP special needs population. Experience with Low German or Spanish would be an asset.

#### **OUR COMMUNITY**

Windsor-Essex County is one of the most affordable communities in Canada. Low housing prices mean space for growing families and other living expenses are comparatively low. We have the longest growing season in Canada and many parks and outdoor areas to enjoy all year-round. The snow never stays long, and the weather is the 7<sup>th</sup> most temperate in Canada.

#### **OUR HOSPITALS**

We have full scope at our two local hospitals. We collaborate with L&D nurses as second attendants at both Windsor Regional Hospital (level II) and Erie Shores Healthcare (level I) with obstetrics but no pediatrics.

We manage inductions, augmentation, and epidurals without transfer of care. Our local obstetricians support shared care models and care is rarely transferred. As such, experience in complex care would be an asset. Our practice promotes shared care whenever possible and maintains excellent co-care for higher risk clients.
