General Registrant Position Starting January 2020

We are looking for a GR to join our group of fun-loving, supportive midwives on a 1-year contract with the goal of transitioning to an ongoing, permanent position.

Ideally the GR would start with orientation and clinic in November 2019 and be on-call in December 2019. Due dates would start January 2020. Caseload is already established. This position is for 32 BCCs in a shared-care model. For the right candidate, the start time and call model may be flexible.

CMK is a well-established group of 13 midwives who are committed to supporting one another to maintain a work/life balance through different team/call schedules and strong administrative support. We maintain clinical and practice based protocols and are committed to consensus-based decision-making. We use Accuro in clinic making chart prep a breeze! We are strong advocates for home birth and we would welcome applicants who share our commitment to supporting choice of birthplace.

We have a solid working relationship with Leadership, Obstetrical staff, and Nursing at Kingston Health Sciences Centre (KHSC), a level 3 teaching hospital. We enjoy the supportive environment that has developed there over the years. Midwives are actively involved in and sit on hospital and community committees. Our scope at KHSC includes epidurals and foley inductions and we are working on protocols to expand our scope (i.e. ECV, oxytocin IOL...). We are able to offer water births in hospital in newly installed birth pools!

Our hospital is affiliated with Queen's University, which allows for educational opportunities including working as a preceptor for RN, NP, Medical students and GP fellows. As well some of our past and present midwives have taken individual courses and/or completed a Masters degree at Queen's.
