Family Health Midwives has a vacancy for a **Full-Time Midwife for February/March 2021**. There is some flexibility with the start date for an applicant that is a good fit for our team!

The position is for a 1 year contract, with possibility to extend into a long-term position.

Family Health Clinic was founded originally in 1982 as a naturopathic medicine clinic, and added Registered Midwives in 1998. The clinic is situated in central Langley, in the Fraser Valley, a fast growing area with many young families. The Fraser Valley is still quite rural with a variety of organic farms, wineries and markets, opportunities for horseback riding, hiking, canoeing, close to camping, skiing and more! Langley is only 45 minutes from downtown Vancouver, for the perfect balance of city and country.

Family Health Midwives work in a <u>small team model</u>, with a shared caseload of 3-4 EDD's per midwife. Our team is committed to maintaining a satisfying work/life balance, working 1 day of clinic and 2-3 days of call each week. The midwives enjoy 24hr call shifts with the occasional 48hr shift, and 6-8 weeks vacation/year is encouraged. Our team uses electronic charting and faxing, and is well supported by an MOA 3 days/week.
