FHMW is a rural team of three midwives who work in collaboration with family physicians through the High River Low Risk Maternity Clinic out of the High River General Hospital in Southern Alberta, just south of Calgary. We are a fully integrated part of the team, and enjoy good respectful working relationships with family doctors, obstetricians and nurses. The team at High River General Hospital is passionately devoted to evidenced based care, protecting the normality of low risk pregnancy and birth, and the support of the family through the childbearing year. This position is funded through the Midwifery Alternative Relationship Plan funding (MARP) for the equivalent of 30 courses of care.

Responsibilities include 24 hour call shifts in hospital, pre- and post-natal clinic, group prenatal classes and on call time for water birth coverage. At this time FHMW does not offer out of hospital birthing options, as this is a hospital based program.

Interested applicants should:

- Possess current (or be eligible for) registration with the College of Midwives of Alberta, and have current CPR, NRP, and Emergency Skills Certification. MOREOb or ALARM desirable.
