CAM is now accepting applications from members interested in being part of a project advisory committee on gender-based violence

About the GBV Knowledge Translation Project

CAM, in collaboration with NACM, has launched a project to build midwives' capacity to recognize and respond safely to child maltreatment, children's exposure to intimate partner violence, and intimate partner violence. The three-year project is funded by the Public Health Agency of Canada (PHAC).

About the Project Advisory Committee

Our project will be informed by the knowledge and expertise of midwives across Canada.

Responsibilities:

- Offer guidance into the staff-led components of the project (surveys, professional development trainings, resources). This could include:
 - reviewing survey research findings (survey at project beginning)
 - providing input on the content and format of professional development workshops and webinar outlines, and supporting materials
 - suggesting trainers or facilitators
 - providing input on resource development

- Review materials that are produced by CAM before dissemination, including:
 - professional development workshop and webinar content, and supporting materials
 - resources developed for midwives and their clients
 - surveys

Selection Criteria

The selection committee will appoint midwife experts on the committee based on qualifications, interest, expertise, and representation.

Qualifications:

- Familiar with research on gender-based violence and family violence;
- Broad knowledge of regional, rural and national contexts;
- Represent or work with communities disproportionately impacted by violence, including Indigenous, racialized, newcomer, and LGBTQ2S+ populations;
- Experience on advisory committees or working groups with non-profit organizations;
- Minimum of 5 yrs midwifery practice experience;
- Available to participate in at least 3 meetings per year for the duration of the three-year project.
