**Call for Resolutions to the AGM**

**DEADLINE: Friday October 15<sup>th</sup>, 2021 – 11:59pm (ET)**

Each year, **voting members in good standing** have an opportunity to submit resolutions for discussion and voting at the Annual General Meeting.

**WHAT IS A RESOLUTION**

Resolutions are the means by which members of CAM can raise issues for discussion by colleagues at the CAM AGM and call for action by the elected representatives.

**TYPES OF RESOLUTIONS**

- Any Resolution that does not change our bylaws requires an affirmative vote of 50% plus one, of the votes cast at the meeting to pass.
- Any Resolution that alters our existing bylaws requires a two-thirds majority vote of the votes cast.
- The quorum for the annual general meeting is 30 full voting members, representing at least two-thirds of the member associations.

**HOW TO PREPARE A RESOLUTION**

- Identify the issue or idea.
- Compile background information, which will assist with the development of the resolution and supporting rationale. Include the full name, phone number and email of the submitter.

**WHAT ACTION IS TAKEN ON RESOLUTIONS THAT ARE SUBMITTED**

Resolutions are reviewed for clarity, legality, and to avoid duplication. At this time, submitters may be contacted if revisions are required.

**DEADLINE TO SUBMIT RESOLUTIONS**
